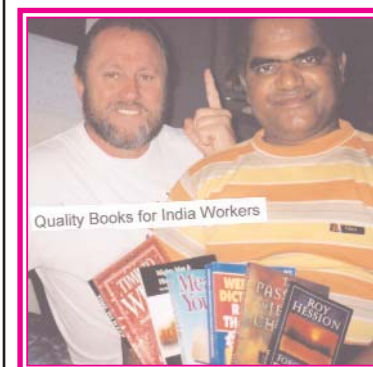

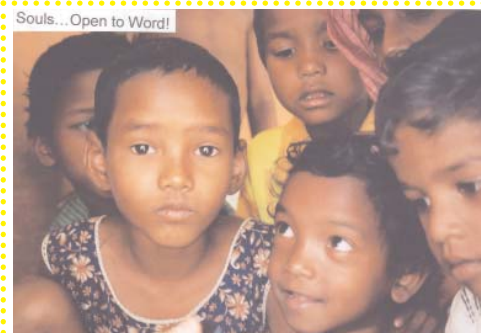
### Another ... BUS



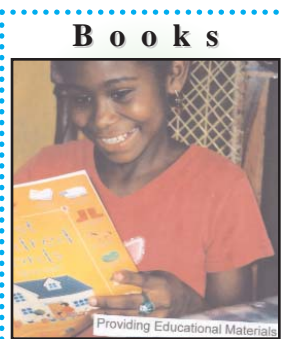
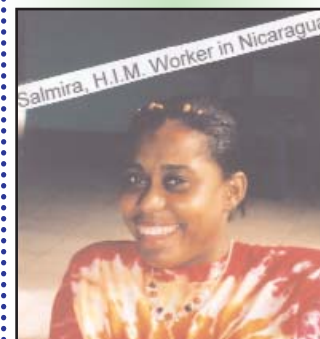
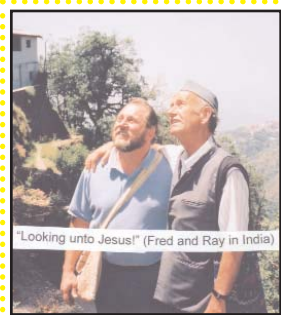

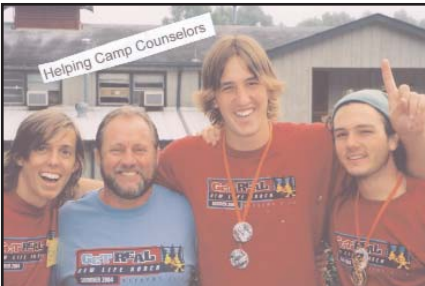
**JoAnne LaRue** stays busy on the east coast reaching children and adults in various ways.

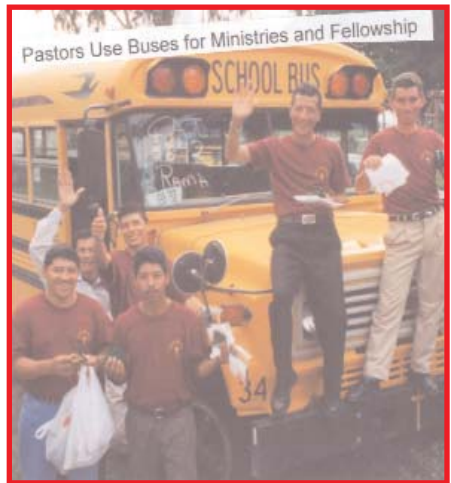

From the **HEART** of Vicky Rogers...

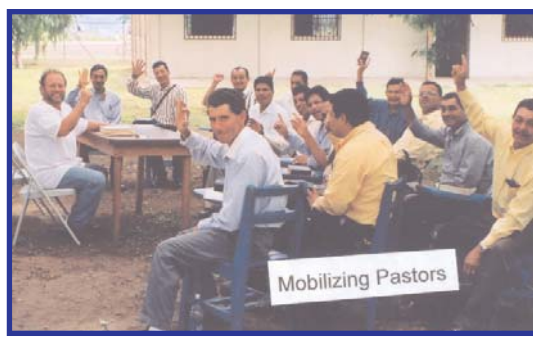
