DIRECT IMPACTS FROM YOUR PRAYERS IN INDIA

God has raised up a very strategic team of six willing disciples to impact India in the upcoming new year and for eternity! Angie Cole, Becky Brooks, Carla Kormanik, Joe Kormanik, Dr. Austin Phillips, and Fred Kornis need your PRAYER as they plan a trip for early next year.

As some of you are aware, recent outbursts of fanatical violence in India have targeted innocent Christians, leaving more than 5,000 homes destroyed and hundreds dead. As with all extremists and violent cults and religions, the only hope is CHRIST! It takes months of preparation with proper visas, passports, tickets, literature, planning, praying, packing, etc. to IMPACT a targeted area with the Gospel. The budget for just this one trip will be nearly \$20,000! If everyone reading this would give \$12, this would pay for the India project.



...IN NICARAGUA

We currently have another team of 20 people investing a week in Nicaragua with hundreds of kids being reached with baseball 'clinics', equipment, literature, preaching and Bibles! Pray for traveling mercies as this team plans on leaving November 28. A big thank you to those individuals and organizations that have donated specifically for this outreach.



So we need prayer NOW as we press on till He comes. Oh God help us to get 'radical' about sharing eternal life with those who have so little!
