As many of you know, Pastor Varghese and members of his family were killed in a car crash a few months ago. It is believed to have been a deliberate attack by Hindu extremists, though no arrests were made. His wife Shiny and two sons survived, but need support to pay medical bills and for living expenses. Here is an update we received from his son. Jornet:

"Thank you for calling. Mom was very happy she could talk to you. She couldn't talk to you fluently so she handedme the phone. God's grace we are all diving good. We had to move and are staying at another ented home. My younger brother Jowin is going to school, He is in third grade now. But Jeswin is not well yet. He needs one more surgery. He is having spiral problem. The surgery is planning to be done on July. Only after surgery could he go to school. Morn is almost better but she is not fully recovered. I can now walk without help. I am planning to accend college starting next mornh. For six morths! was in bed nest but God healed me. Now I'm having back pain but I'm doing better. Thank you for your concern for us. None of us are able to work yet. We are living each day by His grace. We have debts to pay and they are becoming a big pecclem. We were having a church ministry here, but after the accident we couldn't do the ministry and we had to close it as there was no one to continue doing. The magazine work is also pending, I wish to continue doing it to tall don't have sponsors and I am not able to find finance for it. My health is getting better. Thank you for praying and supporting us."

How did they find out I was so wealthy!?? Seriously, with over 40 years in various ministry involvements and partnerships... Loet appeals like bees on honey!
