Partnered with US organization Water With Blessings: Took 85 water filters; each guaranteed for a million gallons of clean, safe water; each woman agrees to filter for 3 other families which totals 425 families impacted by these filters; each filter costs \$40; provided training.



Livelihood Project: Investing in things like hetties or sows, sari sari stores (small shops with basic necessities), mango trees; helping the families build a sustainable source of income & teaching them how to continue to grow that business to provide for their families.



Ministering to Pastors: While Angel and Cotina were doing the women's seminars, Fred and Ali spoke with the local Pastors, encouraging and pouring into them.



Mobilizing HIM Partners: Two Nicaraguan PALS were part of the team - their gifts of prayer, singing and technology were a great asset to the team, and a blessing for the people.



Met with HIM PALS Noe, Hermie, Erlie - visited their churches and encouraged them and their staff.



3 full day Women's Seminars: Teachings and testimonies over Freedom in Christ - over 400 women attended, many traveling hours to get there, some even walking over mountains.



Street evangelism: Fred took every opportunity to evangelize to people in the streets, restaurants, basketball court, Sunday School, etc. using his ropes and sketches.



Went to visit 2 homes that were destroyed by a recent typhoon - prayed over them and HIM is assisting them in rebuilding.
